
AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

N. Theodore Lillie , being duly sworn, on oath says
he is and during all the times herein stated has been the
and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of New Brighton in the County of Ramsey and it has its known office of issue in the Village of New Brighton in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a petition for a project to Improve Ramsey County Ditch Number 8 is pending before the Board of Managers of the Rice Creek Watershed District. The Engineer's Report and the Appraisers' Report for the proposed improvement designated as Rice Creek Project No. 77-22 are on file with the Managers. The Appraisers' Report is available for inspection at the City Hall of the City of Shoreview, 4665 North Victoria, City of Shoreview, and at the office of the Rice Creek Watershed District at 3385 Lexington Avenue North, Suite 177, Arden Hills, MN 55112, phone no. 483-0634. The Engineer's Report is available for inspection at the said office of the District.

NATURE OF THE IMPROVEMENT

The project consists of the relocation and enlargement of Ramsey Co. Ditch No. 8 upstream from the point of the South right-of-way line of Vicki Lane to its terminus on Ramsey Co. Road J and all of Branch No. 2, all located in the plat of Evergreen Shores, Shoreview, Ramsey County, Minnesota.

ASSESSMENTS FOR BENEFITS — FINDINGS OF BENEFITS

Affected properties as shown in the Appraisers' Report and Engineer's Report will not be subject to an assessment for costs associated with this improvement. However, there will be a finding of benefits and damages on which the cost of future repairs to Ramsey Co. Ditch No. 8 will be calculated if and when future repairs are necessary to maintain the said drainage system.

TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING

The Board of Managers of the Rice Creek Watershed District will hold a public hearing on the petition, the Engineer's Report and the Appraisers' Report on the 16th day of March, 1983, at 7:30 o'clock p.m., at the said

City Hall of Shoreview, Shoreview, Minnesota, as required by Minnesota Statutes Section 112.54.

All parties interested in the proposed improvement

are required by law to appear before the Managers at said time and place and there present their objections, if any they have, and show cause why an order should not be made by the Managers granting the petition and confirming the reports of the engineer and of the appraisers and ordering the establishment and construction of the proposed improvement.

Pursuant to M.S. Sec. 112.53, a map of the affected area is included in this notice to identify the area and property affected by the said drainage system as indicated by the said reports.
