Removed 20 in. cast iron monument; found 1 in. by 18 in. long iron, 21 in. down. Removed iron and set a 20 in. cast iron in place of iron. Iron not in same place as old cast iron monument. Set manhole assembly, November 13, 1998.

Tied out monument for removal during reconstruction of Silver Lake Road, April 12, 2002.

Removed manhole and 20 in. cast iron monument, May 8, 2003.

Reset a 20 in. cast iron monument down 18 in; contractor to set a cast iron manhole assembly, November 17, 2003.

Tied monument, March 1, 2005.

Retied monument, July 13, 2010.
