The undersigned Citizens and freeholders of the
County of Ramsey ^{and} State of Minnesota recognizing
the fact that the section and quarter section posts

established by United States Government in Ramsey County
 are in many cases entirely destroyed and lost and
 that in a very few years those posts now remaining will
 be entirely gone and that in view of the facts that the
 lands in Ramsey County are very valuable, and
 each year are increasing largely in value, it is
 desirable that the section and quarter section corners
 should be permanently fixed and marked by
 enduring monuments of iron or stone, while it is
 possible, to also reference being had to such governmental
 posts as are now in existence and capable of being
 identified by satisfactory evidence.

Now therefore we respectfully petition your Honorable
 Board that you will proceed at once to cause a
 new survey of the lands in Ramsey County to be
 made, and cause such section & quarter sections
 and meanders corners in said County to be ascertained
 according to law and permanently fixed by suitable
 monuments of iron or stone
