Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 10 o'clock a.m. this date the following members being present: Gray, Hardick, Lott, Powers, Guehl, Wright & Chairman Kiefer. Absent: None.

Minutes of last regular & intervening meetings read & approved as read.

Communications

A communication was received from the County Surveyor informing the Board that 70 granite monuments had been set on section corners in Mounds View, 65 in White Bear, 55 in New Canada and 50 in Rose Town, and that it would require 230 more monuments to complete the work.

Communication received & placed on file (See Resolution)

By Commissioner Powers. Resolved that the County Surveyor be authorized to purchase 150 granite monuments & to set the same at Government section and quarter section & meander corners. Monuments to be eight inches square and thirty

inches long and the cost not to exceed 75 cents each, free on cars.
at St. Paul, the cost to be charged to the Revenue fund.
