1890-P. M. Dahl acting in the capacity of the Hennepin County Surveyor found a stake in the center of a road that had been set according to ties by Egan. Dahl set a sandstone monument 0.5 of a foot below the surface of the road.

1937-C. E. Lewis in conjunction with the WPA resurvey program initiated by Hennepin County found a 3/4 inch iron pipe in the center of 29th Avenue using old ties. Lewis set a concrete monument 8 inches down.

1956-L. Seaberg in conjunction with the Hennepin County resurvey program found a granite monument flush with the surface in the centerline of the road.

The corner location has been maintained and perpetuated by the Hennepin County Surveyors office through the present time.
