He further deposes and says that in the month of January, A.D. 1907, he made a survey of the premises and real estate shown on the above diagram, the same being, - The North one half (N 1/2) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the North east quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty-eight (28), Range Twenty-three (23) according to the Government Survey thereof. Also all of the North one half (N 1/2) of Lot Two (2), Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty-eight (28), Range Twenty-three (23) according to the Government survey thereof, which is situated East of the easterly line of the Mississippi River Boulevard, No. 2, as said easterly line is determined and defined by the recorded plat of said Mississippi River Boulevard No. 2.
