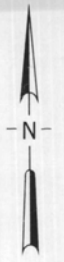


GRADING PLAN FOR: B. J. BERNTSON

SILT FENCE DETAIL

INSTALLATION
 Normal construction procedures can be used to install 5-foot high silt barriers. The following are suggestions for installation which may need to be adapted depending upon site conditions. The barrier should be located along the boundaries of the construction site. Spacing of posts depends on the type of post used and the anticipated sediment flow. Usually six to ten feet between posts will suffice.
 Five 6" of fabric should be considered at the bottom of the fence for ten-in to prevent sediment from passing under the sediment control barrier fabric. Leaving the excess fabric on the ground and piling it up at the end.
