12	District Cooling St Paul, Inc., MCI Network Services, Inc., Comcast of Saint Paul, Inc., Saint Paul
13 14	Regional Water Services, and the Department of Public Works, made a part hereof by this reference and filed in the office of the City Clerk of Saint Paul, the City, for itself and on behalf of these corporations
