Description:

Lot 2, Block 5, Alexander Grant Park; and
 * That part of the following described premises lying Easterly of Lake Johanna Boulevard and Southerly of the Northerly line of Lot 2, Block 5, Alexander Grant Park extended Easterly. All that part of Govt Lot 3 in Section 33, T.30, R.23 bounded and described as follows: commencing at a point on the Westerly line of said Lot 3 distant 754.28 feet North from the SWly corner of said Govt Lot 3, being the point of beginning of the land to be described, thence North on the West line of said Lot 3 188.57 feet to a point, thence Easterly at right angle with last named line and parallel to and with the Southerly line of said Lot 3 to the Easterly line of said Lot 3, being the shores of Lake Johanna, thence Southerly along the shore of Lake Johanna to the Northeast corner of that certain tract of land conveyed by Aurelia Perrett to Anthony Perry on Oct. 14, 1904, thence Westerly along the Northerly line of said Anthony Perry's land to the Westerly line of said Lot 3, the place of beginning, excepting however, a strip 50 feet in width over and across the South 188.57 feet of the North 565.71 feet of Lot 3, Section 33, T.30, R.23, being 25 feet on each side of center line of right of way of Transmission line of St. Croix Falls Minnesota Improvement Company as now located, excepting also a 66 foot strip used as a County Road, across the East end and also the West 33 feet running North and South used as a road.
