WHEREAS, upon the petition in writing of thirty-eight legal voters residing within the limits of the Townships of Rose and Mounds View in the County of Ramsey as the route hereinafter described for a public highway through the said towns, a copy of their petition having been first duly posted as required by law, we, the Committee on Roads and Bridges of the said County of Ramsey, did on the 10th day of April A.D. 1872 personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a county road to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 3, Township 29 North of Range 23, running thence due North or as hear as practice able upon the Section Line to the Northeast corner of Northeast quarter of Section 22, Township 30 North of Range 23.

And having, before determining to lay out said County Read fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same, notices thereof having been posted up in three public places near the line of said road to days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time appointed for hearing such reasons and none having been offered against the laying out of said County Road and being of opinion that petent surveyor who made a report to us as follows:



Therefore we have estimated the advantages of said County Road equal to any and all the damages of the above named owners of lands severally along the line of said County Road as above described in said County.
