The committee for laying out a county road from St. Paul to Little Canada to join the State road there presented the following report:

We have laid out said road commencing at Paine St. by the houses of Messrs. Brainard Dillon & Hammond and following the Section line as far as possible connected said road with the Kettle River road at the house of Caraese Keisen in the Town of Little Canada;

That we consulted the wishes of the different property holders on said road as many as we could find and all seemed perfectly satisfied;

That we had said road surveyed by the Co. Surveyor and herewith submit to your board a map and plan of said survey.

The report was approved of and the map and plan filed in the office of the Register of Deeds accordingly.
