Whereas, upon the petition of eight (8) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the home stead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places in said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road to be laid out is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section one (1) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) running East three quarters (3/4) of a mile on the Town line between the towns of Mounds View and Centerville to terminate at the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section one (1) Township thirty (30) Range twenty three (23).

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 5th day of May A.D. 1894 at the house of Henry Bucher by causing copies of such notices to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants, of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such new road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

AWARD OF DAMAGES

Whereas, a road was laid out on the Town line on the 5th day of May A.D. 1894, by us, the Supervisors of said Town of Mounds View on the petition of eight (8) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of said road, which said road is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and,

Whereas, a part of the damages sustained by reason of laying out said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, and the owners of some of the lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages.
