Whereas, Upon the petition of a majority of legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk who fortwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vis:

The Town Board of Supervisors met in joint meeting with the Town Board of Centerville, Aneka County for the purpose of examine the route of a road in Section six (6) Township thirty (30) Range twenty two (22). There were present W.A. Gall, Louis Labore and Nels Nelson Supervisors of the Town of White Bear and Jas. Lamotte and Peter Kammerer Supervisors of the Town of Centerville. They did examine said route and being of the opinion that the public interest would be promoted they granted the prayer of the petitioners. They also entered into an agreement with the Board of Centerville Town, whereby said Town of Centerville is to open said newly laid out road and put it in good condition and be reimbursed by the Town of White Bear to the extent of a \$125.00. They also divided said Town line road the Town of Centerville agreeing to take care of the East half and the Town of White Bear of the West half of said road.
