And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the---day of----A.D.---, at--causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against ---- the same, and being of the opinion that such----was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to-said road, and caused a survey hereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:
