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County Surveyor Geates them reported that the request of the Town Board of NEW CANADA has been considered, and it is recommised that BOCK STREET from County Road"A-2" to County Road "D", a distance of two and one-half miles be added to the COUNTY ROAD System beginning January 1, 1933. This road has been graded and grapeled during the past two years to meet the standards for secondary county roads. He also recommended that their request for taking ever and maintaining CORTLAND STREET from County Road "A" to County Road "A-2" be decided as this street does not meet any standards of sounty road construction and should therefore not be considered until it has been graded to meet the standard requirements of a secondary county road.
