#### AWARD OF DAMAGES

State of Minnesota, County of Ramsey, Town of Meunds View, SS:

Thereas, a road was laid out on the 29th day of July, A.B. 1896, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Hounds View on the petition of 14 legal voters who are fresholders and residents of said Town within two miles of said road, which said road—— is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors! Order, made by us, and——

whereas, a part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out of said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the eweers of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages.
