Whereas, upon the petition of fourteen (14) legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at a point where the so-called Silver Lake Road is intersected by the south boundary line of section thirty (30) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) said County Town and State aforementioned, thence west on the dividing line between section thirty (30) thirty-one (31) in said County Town and State to the west boundary line of said Ramsey County.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the twenty-ninth (29th) day of July A.D. 1896, at J.M. Patten's residence in said Town of Mounds View causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass. by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out of the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point where the so-called Silver Lake road is intersected by the south boundary line of section thirty (30) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) said Town County and State aforementioned thence west on the dividing line between sections thirty (30) and thirty-one (31) in said town County and State to the west boundary line of said Ramsey County.

Beginning at a point where the so called Silver Lake Road is intersected by the south boundary line of section thirty (30), township thirty (30), range twenty-three (23), said county town and State aforementioned, thence east on the dividing line between section thirty (30), and thirty-one (31), in said town, County and State to the west boundary line of said Ramsey County.

AWARD OF DAMAGES

State of Minnesota, County of Ramsey, Town of Mounds View, SS:

Whereas, a road was laid out on the 29th day of July, A.D. 1896, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Mounds View on the petition of 14 legal voters who are freeholders and residents of said Town within two miles of said road, which said road----- is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and-----

Whereas, a part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out of said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
