





#### SUPERVISORS ! ROAD ORDER

STATE OF MINNESOTA) COUNTY OF RAMSET ) SS TOWN OF NEW CAMADA)

Whereas, Upon the petition of nine (9) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or Pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be widened from a two (2) red to a four (4) rod road, which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed widening is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vis:

Beginning at the SV corner of the MV2 of the MV2 Section 24, Township 25, Range 22, thence East on the center line of the MV2 and the ME2 of said section

to the center of the HET of said Section 24, Township 25, Range 22.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty (30) days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and

place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit:

On the 15th day of June, 1914 at Wm. H. Dorland, cousing copies of such notice to be posted in three (3) public places in said Town, at least ten (16) days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above minut in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the widening the same, and being of opinion that such widening was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to establish said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the SW corner of the NW2 of the NW2 Section 24, Termship 25, Range 22, thence East on the center line of the NW2 and the NB2 of said section

to the center of the MR; of said Section 24, Township 28, Range 22.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hearly widened and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road 4 rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.

Whereas, A road was laid out on the 15th day of July 1914, by we the Supervisors of the said town of New Ganada on the petition of eight (5) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or Pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors Order, made by us, and-

whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out establishing said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the ewners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages.
