



BOAD ORDER FOR CHANGE OF COUNTY ROAD

August 19, 1907

Beginning at the southeast corner of section 3, township 29, range 23, thence due north on the section line, as near as practicable to the northeast corner of section 27, township 30, range 23, thence west on the section line, as near as practicable, to the southwest corner of section 22, thence north on the section line, as near as practicable to the northeast corner of section 21, thence west to the quarter post between sections 16 and 21, from thence north through the center of sections 16 and 9, section 4, from thence east, as near as practicable on the section line between sections 4, and 9, 3 and 10 to the center of section 3, from thence to the quarter post between sections 2 and 3, thence to the Columbus Road in said township 30, range 23.

And your petitioners pray that you will change all that portion of said above described highway, which runs as follows:

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the east side of section 3, township 30, range 23, thence northwesterly and southwesterly through the south half of the northeast quarter of said section 3, to the center thereof, thence southwesterly to a point, the quarter quarter section line running east and west through the southwest quarter of said section 3, thence west on the quarter quarter section line through the southwest quarter of said section 3, and the southeast quarter of section 4, to a point on the north and south quarter section line of said section 4, thence south on said quarter section line to the quarter section corner between said section 4, and section 9, township 30, range 23.

And now connected with other roads as follows: Lexington Avenue, at the quarter corner between sections 2 and 3 Hamline Avenue, at center of section 3, town road at section line, between sections 3 and 4 and Kettle River and Mounds View goad at quarter section corner, between sections 4 and 9 so that the same when changed will run as follows:

Beginning at the section corner between sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, township 30, range 23, and running thence west on the section line between sections 3 & 10, 4 and 9, to the section corner between said sections 4 and 9, and sections 5 and 8, And to be connected with other roads as follows:

Lexington Avenue also Turtle Lake Road, at corner of sections 2, 3, 10 & 11, Hamline Avenue at quarter corner, between 3 and 10, town road at corner of section 3, 4, 9 and 10, Kettle River and Mounds View road at quarter corner between sections 4 and 9 and Barlow Road at corner between sections 4, 5, 9 & 10, being an extention of the Turtle Lake Road, two miles west.

Proper service of all persons interested was made according to law,
Final road order dated and adopted August 19, 1907. filed for record with the
County Auditor of Ramsey County, Minnesota. Edward W. Kichmer, August 19th,
1907 of road covering the above described premises and affecting the above
property. This road order originally covered a distance from the southeast
corner of section 3, township 29, range 23, to the northeast corner of section
27, township 30, range 23, thence west on section line to the southwest corner
of section 22, thence north on the section line to the northeast corner of sec.
21, thence west to the quarter post between section 16 and 21, thence north
through the center of sections 16 and 9 to section 4, thence east between sections 4 and 9, 3 and 10 to the center of section 3, from thence to the quarter
post between sections 2 and 3 thence to the Columbus Road. in said township 30.

Examining the location of Barlow Road, now Cleveland road, I found that the connection with Barlow Road could be only at corner between sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 of township 30, range 23.

Road order, dated August 19, 1907. At the present time a portion of heretofore laid out road at present divided into four roads, One U. S. Highway and three county roads.

- Road #1. U. S. Highway #10 or Lexington Avenue from the southeast corner of section 3, in Rose Town to the northeast corner of section 34 in Mounds View.
- Road #2. County Road #3 or Lexington Avenue now a county road from the southeast corner of section 27 in Mounds View, north on section line to the half section line of section 3, thence north and northwesterly and westerly and northwesterly to the Anoka County Line.
- Road #3. County Road "F" or County Road 29-A from the southeast corner of section 22 in Mounds View to a point of Shelling Avenue in the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 22.
- Road #4. Snelling Avenue of County Road 29-B from the terminus point of County Road "F" on the section line between sections 21 and 22 running due north one mile (1), and terminating at the Manomin Road now Designated as State Trunk Highway #56 of County Road "G".
