Resolved that the County Surveyor is hereby instructed to make a survey of the Pelander Read from city limits to Hast County Line, Section 23, 24, Touriship 28, Range 22 and report to Board what is best to do on the same so that it can be made passable. Book M-Page #511.

In further consideration of the application of the Term Beard of New Canada in regard to the County taking over the maintenance of cartain highway, dated July 2, and which had previously been referred by the Board to the County Surveyor for investigation and recommendation, County Surveyor Schulz reported that he had made a careful investigation of this proposition and his Department is willing to take up the maintenance of these roads, and so recommend to the County Board.

After a discussion of this request and also Mr. Schuls, Countssioner Swan moved, seconded by Commissioner Moeller that on and after January 1, 1936 that the following roads located in New Canada Turnship be designated as County Roads:

- The East County Line from Highwood Avenue to Carver Avenue.
- Carver Avenue from the East County Line to the City Limits
- of St. Paul. 3. Cortland Street from County Road A-2 to Larpentour Avenue.

Adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Moeller, Peter, Rohland, Sehmidt, Swan and Gehan. Hays: Garr. Commissioner Carr emplained his vote "Ho" by stating that he was opposed to the additional expense which the County would incur in maintaining these roads.

In 1933 the State of Minnesota took over 50.6 miles of County road as trunk highway. During the same period, or about the same time, Ranger County took over Book Street which at that time was a Township road, before Frost Avenue and County Road "D", a distance of 2.5 miles, making a new reduction in Rangey County maintained highway of 46.1 miles.
