WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Wm. H. Lain, T. F. Conroy, Willie Molitor, Olivier Lemay, A. F. Hanf, P. H. McCauley, Arthur W. Herrick, Charles A. Anderson, H. L. Weber, W. S. Batsen, Louis Schmitt, James Drea, Ole Gunderson, Cyril Lacasse, Wm. Nadeau, ~~Edw. Nadeau~~, Fred Nadeau, Calix Nadeau, Louis E. Gilbert and Herman Molitor, nineteen legal voters residing within three miles of the road hereinafter described, (the opening of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said towns, did, on the 8th day of October, A.D. 1919, personally examine the road proposed in said petition, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot Five (5), Sec. 36, T. 31, R. 22 in Anoka Co. and the Northeast corner of Lot Four (4), Sec. 3, T. 30, R. 22, in Ramsey County and running due West to the easterly shore of Otter Lake the proposed road to be four (4) rods wide,

and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the _____ day of _____ A.D. _____ cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

The proposed road to be four (4) rods wide.

The Town Board of Centerville, Anoka County and the Town Board of White Bear, Ramsey County, Minnesota, met at SE corner, Gov. Lot 5, Section 36, Township 31, Range 22, Anoka County and the NE corner of Gov. Lot 4, Section, 3, Township 30, Range 22, Ramsey County, as per notice of hearing dated Sept. 26, 1919. Present George Kohler, Eusibe Picard and W.J. Houle of Centerville and Louis Labore and Gus Hane of White Bear Township. On motion made and carried George Kohler was chosen chairman of the joint Board meetings after the reading of the Notice of Hearing all reasons for or against the laying out of said road were heard, and on motion made by Louis Labore and seconded by W.J. Houle, being of the opinion that the proposed new road would be for the benefit of the general public, granted the prayer of the petitioners and established the road as called for in petition filed Sept. 1st, 1919.
