The Town Board of Wenterville, Anoka County and the Town Board of White Bear, Ramsey County, Minnesota, met at SE corner, Gov. Lot 5, Section 36, Township 31, Range 22, Anoka County and the NE corner of Gov. Lot 4, Section, 3, Township 36, Range 22, Ramsey County, as per notice of hearing dated Sept. 26, 1919. Present George Kohler, Eusibe Picard and W.J. Houle of Centerville and Louis Labore and Gus Hane of White Bear Township. On motion made and carried George Kohler was chosen chairman of the joint Board meetings after the reading of the Notice of Hearing all reasons for or against the laying out of said road were heard, and on motion made by Louis Labore and seconded by W.J. Houle, being of the epinion that the proposed new road would be for the benefit of the general public, granted the prayer of the petitioners and established the road as called for in petition filed Sept. 1st, 1919.
