At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County held December 3rd, 1906, a copy of the report of the Committee appointed by us at our session August 20th, 1906 to examine the road heretofore known as 78th Street, was duly returned, by which said report it appears that the said commissioners were not at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be changed viz:

Beguning at a point on the southerly line of section four (4), township twenty-nine (29), range thirty-two (32), in the Town of New Ulm, running thence (in a northeasterly, northerly and northwesterly direction) along the center line of said section four (4), township twenty-nine (29), range thirty-two (32), and running thence (in a northeasterly, northerly and northwesterly direction) along the center line of said section four (4), township twenty-seven (27), twenty-five (25), twenty-three (23), twenty-one (21), eleven (11), and ten (10). The board declared petition reasonable on its face and a hearing on same was set for October 11, 1906 at 3 o'clock P.M. to be held at E. H. Hobel residence at Bald Eagle. The Board also decided that a hearing be held on said petition at the Court House and City Hall, St. Paul, on October 12th, 1906 at 10 o'clock A.M. same commissioners were appointed to view the proposed change of road, attend the hearing and to report to Board.

In answer to your favor of August 17th, last, I beg leave to inform you that I will donate a strip of land through my farm at Bald Eagle Lake, north of the Water Works' ditch, as surveyed by Mr. Armstrong, the county surveyor. ~~free of charge whatsoever~~. The only thing I want the County Board to grant, in view of the fact that I give this valuable right-of-way and thereby save the County at least \$15,000 by its not having to put up an iron bridge across the creek and swamp, is that they agree to macadamize the road from the north end of the contemplated change south to Smith Hotel, so as to connect with the macadam there now.

When you consider that this road is to be built in all events, and that I give the land free, thereby damaging my farm in cutting it up, I think this is a reasonable request, especially as the present Board has shown its willingness and desire to make good and permanent roads wherever it can. If the Board has not got the money to macadamize the above mentioned strip this year, I am willing to let it go over to next year, provided the Board will agree to do it then.
