Whereas, on the third (3) day of May, 1887, a petition signed by \$4 freeholders of said county, was presented to us praying for the location and extention of the county read known as the St. Paul, White Bear and Bald Bagle read, and being satisfied that at least 20 days notice theyout has been given before the session of the Beard, by posting up notices on three of the most public places in each of the tewns through which such highway is proposed to be located, we hereby appoint John Kowin, See, Mitch, Lorenzo Heyt, Chas Leidman and M.J. Dely, members of this Beard, a countities to examine such proposed extention, and hereby designated June let, at 2 o'clock P.M. at the term house, in the village of White Bear, in said County as the time when, and the place where such countities will most for each purpose upon said route.

At a meeting of the Board of County Countssioners of said County, held June 14, 1887, a copy of the report of the countitee appointed by us at our last session to examine the read herein after named, having been daily returned, by which said report it appears that the said Countitee not at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway to be extended, vis:
