Report of Committee

Your committee to whom was referred the petition of G. U. Bacon, H. T. Fairchild, John S. Puer, and others, praying for the laying out of a highway described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the Hudson Road where the east and west line between sections 35 and 36 intersects said Hudson Road in McLean Township, thence running north along said east and west line between sections 35 and 36 and section 25 and 26 until it intersects the present road known as the Stillwater Road in the Town of New Canada.

Beg to report that they met at the junction of the Stillwater road on Tuesday, October 28, 1894, at 10 o'clock, A.M. and after hearing Messrs. S. Potter, D.J. Hennessy and A. Watter, for and against said petition, would recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted and that the benefits and damages be assessed to the owners or supposed owners as follows:

Sacho, deceased, to vacate the plat of Bennett's Harvester Works Addition to the City of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minn., except for the following named streets and avenues, to-wit: All of Llewella Avenue; that part of Harvester Avenue lying between the West line of Llewella Avenue and the West line of Woods Avenue; that part of Woods Avenue lying northerly of the South line of Harvester Avenue; all of Cherry Street; and that part of the Stillwater Road now used as a public road.

**Findings of Fact and Order for Judgment.**

This matter came duly on to be heard before the undersigned Richard D. O'Brien, one of the judges of this Court, at a special term thereof held on the 4th day of August, 1927, and again at a special term thereof held on the 11th day of August, 1927, pursuant to the order for hearing made herein on the 9th day of June, 1927; the hearing of said matter having been duly continued from the 30th day of June, 1927, the date of hearing set by said order for hearing.

William P. Westfall, Esq., appeared in his capacity of Examiner of Titles of said Ramsey County; and the applicant and petitioner, Margaret Sacho, appeared in person and by her attorney Horace H. Glenn; and there was no appearance by or on behalf of any other person.

It was made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that the petitioner Margaret Sacho has caused two weeks' published and posted notice of her said application to be given as required by law and by said order for hearing, and that the last publication of such notice was made on the 18th day of June, 1927, being more than ten days before the term at which said application was ordered to be heard; and that said petitioner has caused to be served personally a copy of such application, at least ten days before the term at which said application was ordered to be heard as aforesaid, upon the Chairman of the Town Board of the Township of New Canada, in which the land involved in this proceeding is situated, as provided by law and by said order for hearing; and that this Court has full jurisdiction of the subject-matter of this proceeding and of the parties thereto, and full power and authority to make these findings and order for judgment.

In the Matter of the Application of Margaret Nacho, in her individual right and as executrix of the will of Ellice N. Nacho, deceased, to grant to the plat of Bennett's Harvester for a addition to the City of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minn., one or more the following named streets and avenues, to-wit: All of Biocell Avenue; that part of Harvester Avenue lying between the West line of Biocella Avenue and the West line of Woods Avenue; that part of Woods Avenue lying northerly of the South line of Harvester Avenue; all of Cherry Street; and that part of the Stillwater Road now used as a public road.

Findings of Fact and Order for Judgment.

This matter came duly on to be heard before the undersigned Richard D. O'Brien, one of the judges of this Court, at a special term thereof held on the 4th day of August, 1927, and again at a special term thereof held on the 11th day of August, 1927, pursuant to the order for hearing made herein on the 9th day of June, 1927; the hearing of said matter having been duly continued from the 30th day of June, 1927, the date of hearing set by said order for hearing.

William P. Westfall, Esq., appeared in his capacity of Examiner of Titles of said Ramsey County; and the applicant and petitioner, Margaret Nacho, appeared in person and by her attorney Horace C. Glenn; and there was no appearance by or on behalf of any other person.

It was made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that the petitioner Margaret Nacho has caused two weeks' published and posted notice of her said application to be given as required by law and by said order for hearing, and that the last publication of such notice was made on the 18th day of June, 1927, being more than ten days before the term at which said application was ordered to be heard; and that said petitioner has caused to be served personally a copy of such application, at least ten days before the term at which said application was ordered to be heard as aforesaid, upon the Chairman of the Town Board of the Township of "ow Canada, in which the land involved in this proceeding is situated, as provided by law and by said order for hearing; and that this Court has full jurisdiction over the subject-matter of this proceeding and of the parties thereto, and full power and authority to make these findings and order in this case.

And the Court having heard the evidence offered in support of said application and the arguments of counsel, and having fully considered the same, makes the following

FINDINGS OF FACT.

1. That each and all of the allegations of the application and petition herein are true.
2. That the petitioner and applicant Margaret Zacho is the owner in fee simple of the land described in the application herein, viz: All of Bennett's Marvestor Works Addition to the City of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minn; being the West one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), the West one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), of Section twenty-five (25), in Township twenty-nine (29), of Range twenty-two (22), in said Ramsey County.
3. That the title to said real estate is registered in the office of the Registrar of Titles of said Ramsey County in the name of Elias P. Zacho, in Volume 68 of Register of Titles, on page 113, under Certificate of Title Number 26220; that the said Elias P. Zacho died on the 23rd day of March, 1936, leaving a last will and testament by which the whole of his estate is devised and bequeathed to his widow, Margaret Zacho, the petitioner and applicant herein; that the said will had been duly proved and admitted to probate in and by the Probate Court of the said County of Ramsey in the administration of the estate of the said Elias P. Zacho, and that on the 3rd day of August, 1937, the said Probate Court duly made and entered its final decree in said matter, by which the said real estate is assigned to and vested in the said Margaret Zacho pursuant to said will. A certified copy of the said will, the order admitting the same to probate and the said final decree has been offered and received in evidence herein, and marked "Exhibit B".
4. That the title of the said Margaret Zacho to said real estate is subject to a mortgage in the principal sum of Three thousand

dollars (\$5,000) to Bridget McGuire as mortgagee, registered in the office of the said Registrar of Titles on the 23rd day of June, 1884, as Document Number 69814; and that the said Bridget McGuire has consented to the vacating of the said plat of Bennett's Harvester Works Addition, so prayed for in the petition and application herein, by a written consent dated and acknowledged on the 16th day of June, 1887, which has been offered and received in evidence herein and marked "Exhibit A".

5. That the said plat of Bennett's Harvester Works Addition was filed for record and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Ramsey County on the 24th day of October, 1892, in Book 16 of Town Lots at page 33; that the said real estate is situate in the Township of New Canada in the said County of Ramsey; that none of the streets, alleys, avenues or public ways so sought to be vacated by said application have ever been opened or used as public streets or ways by the public or by any person, and that the same are useless for the purpose for which they were laid out; and that all taxes heretofore levied or assessed against said real estate have been paid in full.

And the Court finds as

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW.

1. That the petitioner and applicant Margaret Macho is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said petition and application, and to the vacating of all of the plat of Bennett's Harvester Works Addition to the City of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minn., except for the following named streets and avenues, viz: All of Blewella Avenue, that part of Harvester Avenue lying between the East line of Blewella Avenue and the West line of Woods Avenue, that part of Woods Avenue lying northerly of the South line of Harvester Avenue, and all of Cherry Street, and to the judgment of this court vacating said plat and accordingly adjudging the title to all streets, alleys and public grounds so vacated to be in the said applicant and petitioner Margaret Macho.

Let judgment be entered accordingly.

The Court further hereby directs that the said Exhibits A and B, being the consent of the said mortgagee Bridget Magnire to such vacation and the certified copy of proceedings in the matter of the estate of said Elias F. Zacho, deceased, be filed forthwith with the Registrar of Titles of said Ramsey County and registered by him, and that thereupon the said Registrar shall issue to the said Margaret Zacho, in her name, a new certificate of title to the said real estate as so vacated, according to law, upon the surrender to him of the said Certificate of Title Number 26220 in the name of Elias F. Zacho; describing said real estate in such new certificate as the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), of Section twenty-five (25), in Township twenty-nine (29), of Range twenty-two (22), according to the United States Government Survey thereof.

And it appearing that the petitioner Margaret Zacho has caused published and posted notice of her said application to be given as required by law and by the order for hearing made by this Court herein on the 9th day of June, 1927, and personal service thereof to be made upon the Chairman of the Town Board of the Township of New Canada, in which the land involved in this proceeding is situated, as provided by law and by said order for hearing; that no appearance has been made herein by or on behalf of any person other than the petitioner and applicant Margaret Zacho; and that this Court has full jurisdiction of the subject-matter of this cause and of the parties hereto,

And the Court having made and filed its findings of fact and order for judgment herein, according to law,

"Now on motion of Horatio H. Glenn, attorney for the said petitioner and applicant Margaret Zacho,

IT IS ADJUDGED AND DECREED That the plat of Bennett's Harvester Works Addition to the City of St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minn., filed for record and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County on the 24th day of October, 1892, in Book 16 of Town Lots at page 33, be and the same is hereby vacated, except for the following named streets and avenues, viz: All of Lowell Avenue, that part of Harvester Avenue lying between the East line of Lowell Avenue and the West line of Woods Avenue, that part of Woods Avenue

lying northerly of the South line of Harvester Avenue, and all of Cherry Street.

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the title to all of the streets, alleys and public grounds so vacated, and to all of the land included within said plat, is in the said petitioner and applicant Margaret Zacho, and she is hereby vested with title thereto.

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a certified copy of this judgment and decree and of the findings of fact and conclusions of law herein be filed in the office of the County Auditor of said Ramsey County, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county.

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Exhibits A and B offered and received in evidence in this proceeding, being the contract of the mortgagor Bridget Zagoiro to such vacation and the certified copy of the will of Elias P. Zacho, deceased, the order of the Probate Court of said Ramsey County admitting said will to probate, and the final decree of said Probate Court in the matter of the estate of said Elias P. Zacho, deceased, be filed forthwith with the Registrar of Titles of said Ramsey County and registered by him, together with a certified copy of this judgment and decree and of the findings of fact and conclusions of law herein, and that thereupon the said Registrar shall issue to the said Margaret Zacho, in her name, a new certificate of title to the said real estate so vacated, according to law, upon the surrender to him of certificate of title Number 26220 in the name of Elias P. Zacho; describing such real estate in said new certificate as the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the NE 1/4 and one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), of Section twenty-five (25), in Township twenty-nine (29), of Range twenty-two (22), according to the
