

The attention of the County Surveyor is respectfully called to the following Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County, Minnesota, adopted at the meeting held on the 19th inst. By Commissioner Leinen:

RESOLVED That the following described highway be, and the same is hereby, constituted and declared as a county road, said road being located in Ramsey County, and outside of the corporated limits of any incorporated city or village therein, and is in pursuance with authority granted under Section 2582 General Statutes of Minnesota for the year 1923.

Beginning at the center of Section 31, Township 30, Range 23, thence westerly along center line of said section a distance of 427.8 ft. thence south 46 deg. 30 min. west a distance of 719.32 ft.; thence south 63 deg. 51 min. west a distance of 518.88 ft.; thence south 80 deg. 31 min. west a distance of 323 ft.; thence north 89 deg. 53 min. west a distance of 513.45 ft. to a point on the west County line which is 1828.55 ft. north of the southwest corner of section 13, Township 30, Range 23.

Supervisors' Road Order

STATE OF MINNESOTA, County of Ramsey, Town of Mounds View, SS

Whereas, Upon the petition of Twenty (20) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be layed out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road 66 ft is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at Silver Lake Road (Center Section 31, Range 23, Township 30) at a point approximately 567.2 ft. South of abutment of Lake to Silver Lake Road and running in a Southwesterly direction, parallel to shore of lake, for approximately 60 rods then continuing in a Westerly direction parallel to South Shore of Lake, 66 Rods to Section Line of (Section 31, Township 30, Range 23) which is the extreme West line of Ramsey County bordering on Anoka County; above road connecting and intersecting with 49th Ave. from Central Ave. (Columbia Heights, Anoka County) which is a proposed cross country highway; Robin Ave. from 49th Ave. running parallel to South westerly shore of lake to above road and Stevens Blvd. proposed road running from Minneapolis, City Limits along the border of Ramsey County and Anoka County.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 12th day of July 1924 at Two O'clock in the afternoon at proposed Road Corner causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above stated in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such road, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the proposed road all were the same, and being of opinion that such proposed road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so presented thereof is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Silver Lake Road, (Center Section 31, Township 30, Range 23,) at a point approximately 567.2 ft. South of abutment of Lake to Silver Lake Road and running in a Southwesterly direction parallel to shore of lake for approximately 60 rods; then continuing in a Westerly direction parallel to South Shore of Lake for 66 Rods to Section line of Section 31, Township 30, Range 23, which is the extreme West line of Ramsey County bordering on Anoka County; above road connecting and intersecting with 49th Ave. from Central Ave. (Columbia Heights, Anoka County) which is a proposed cross country highway; Robin Ave. from 49th Ave. running parallel to Southwesterly shore of lake to above road; and Stevens Blvd., Proposed road running from Minneapolis, City Limits along border of Ramsey County and Anoka County.

It is therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby by granted and recorded and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road four rods (4) wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, County of Ramsey, Town of Mounds View, ss:

Whereas, A road was laid out at Silver Lake on the 12th day of July, 1924, by us the Supervisors of the said Town of Mounds View on the petition of twenty (20) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the lease, deed or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minn. within three (3) miles of said road, which said road was laid out as set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us and Whereas, a part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out—said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which said road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right, taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages, We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
