STATE OF MINNESOTA )  
COUNTY OF RANSEY )  
TOWN OF MOUNDS VIEW )

WHEREAS, upon the petition of six legal voters, residing or owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town at least 20 days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows: of 4 rods wide commencing at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  post on the W. line of Sec. 18 in said Town of Mounds View and running E. & W. on  $\frac{1}{4}$  line to line dividing E. one  $\frac{1}{2}$  and W. one  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 18 thence South on last mentioned line to the N. line of S  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S one  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 18 thence East till it intersects the Rice Lake and St. Paul Road and,

WHEREAS, upon receiving said petition we did, within thirty days make out a Notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 2nd day of August A.D. 1880 at the House of Timothy Kinnane on Sec. 18 in said Town causing copies of such Notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said Notice and being satisfied that the applicant had at least ten days previous to said time caused said Notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which said road is to pass by serving the same by copy left at the usual place of abode of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard all reasons for and against laying out. Such road was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DETERMINED that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the description above given being the center of said road.

(18) in said Town of Mounds View and running East on East and West quarter line to line dividing East one-half and West one-half of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. (18) thence S. on last mentioned line to the N. line of S  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S one  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. (18) then East till it intersects the St. Paul and Rice Lake Road.

To the supervisors of the Town of Mounds View, in the County of Ramsay, State of Minnesota, the undersigned legal voters residing and owning real estate within one mile of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road do hereby petition you to lay out a new road of the width of four (4) rods as follows: Commencing at the quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) post on the west line of Section eighteen (18) Township thirty (30) Range twenty three (23) in said Town of Mounds View and running thence east, on the east, and west quarter line to the line dividing the east one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) and west one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section eighteen (18) thence south on the last mentioned line to the north line of the south one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section eighteen (18) thence east till it intersects the Saint Paul and Rice Lake Road.
