

From the County Surveyor

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners,
Ramsey County, Minnesota;

Gentlemen - Pursuant of instructions issued by your honorable board, I herewith hand you a map of Ramsey County showing the location of all County roads of record therein. The records of the earlier surveys have, it is to be regretted, been of the most indefinite character, and are comprised in some cases of a series of magnetic courses and distances only, without properly defined initial and terminal points, and without showing any connection with the lines of the public surveys. The location of such lines can only be approximately determined by the scanty details of topography found on the original maps, and any attempt to accurately retrace the lines would be futile in the extreme.
