SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Mar. 24, 1934

Whereas, Upon the petition of M. F. Henion, legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed _____ is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at Center of Section 19, T. 30, Range 23, thence running W on the quarter Section line to a point 171 ft. W. of West line of Birch St., as the same is dedicated on plat of Oakwood Manor.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: on the 24 day of March, 1934 at said proposed road causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally, such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the _____ the same, and being of opinion that such _____ was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to _____ said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying the description of which as so _____ is as follows, to-wit: Beginning _____

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road 66 ft. wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
