The undersigned, legal voters of said town who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract with the State of Minnesota, within three miles of the road proposed to be established and opened, herein petition you to lay out the proposed road as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centre line of Lexington Ave. and the North line of Section 3, T. 20, R. 23 and extending east on the said Section line to the intersection with the present road running east and west between Ramsey and Anoka Counties, Being about 3/4 of a mile more or less.

The said road to be 66 feet wide; 33 feet on either side of the above described center line.

The description of the lands over which the said road passes and the names of the owners thereof which are known, as well as the lands the names of whose owners are unknown, are as follows:

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Nov. 18, 1933.

Whereas, upon the petition of J. C. Austin legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Lexington Ave. on the North line of Section 3, T. 30, R. 23, an extending East on the present road running East and West between Ramsey and Anoka Counties, being about 3/4 of a mile more or less.

The said road to be 66 ft. wide 33 ft. on either side of the above described center line.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: on the 18 day of Nov. 1933 at said proposed road, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and say and all reasons for or against the road the same, and being of opinion that such road was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so _____ is as follows, to-wit: Beginning _____ Same as above _____

It is therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road 66 ft. wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
