Whereas, upon the petition of John Grudnoske legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed _____ is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning on the N & S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section line thru Sec. 25, T. 30, R. 23 at the S.E. Cor. of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section, thence West on the South line of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of said N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25 an on the South line of N. $\frac{1}{2}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26 of said Town an ranges to Victoria.

The said proposed road to be 66 ft. wide, 33 ft. on each side of the above described center line.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: on the _____ day of _____ 19____ at said proposed road causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town, at least ten days before such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit; we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the _____

the same, and being of opinion that such _____ was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to _____ said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so _____ is as follows, to-wit: Beginning _____

It is therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this order, and it is declared to be a public road _____ rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.

in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters of said town, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or Pre-emption Laws of the United States, or under contract with the State of Minnesota, within three miles of the road proposed to be established and opened herein petition you to establish and laid out a road as follows: Beginning on the N & S $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. line thru Sec. 25, T. 30, R. 23 at the SE Cor of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section, thence West on the south line of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, and on the south line of the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 of said town and range to Victoria St. Road so called.

The said proposed road to be 66 feet wide, 33 feet on each side of the above described center line.
