Whereas, upon the petition of twenty-four (24) legal voters, who can real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed public cartway is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vist

Beginning at the SW. corner of the MW. quarter of Section 26, Township 36, Range 23, thence running east on the line between the SW. quarter of the MW. quarter of Section 26, Township 30, Range 23 and the MW. quarter of the SW. quarter of said section, a distance of one quarter of a mile.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 20th day of April A.B. 1911, at 2 e'clock P.M. at the residence of Mrs. Johanna Konlgku causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said. Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, esmeed said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the compants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said compants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we preceded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such cartway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning: (Seme as above description)

It is therefore Ordered and Determined that a read be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway two (2) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said read.
