Whereas, upon the petition of ten (10) legal voters, who own real estate, or who eccupy real estate under the homestead or pre-amption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the eartway proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Term, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly, shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed-----is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vis:

Beginning at the morthwest corner of the continuest quarter (57.1/4) of section number two (2) Tounghip thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) Themse running in an eneterly course on the quarter section line of said section two (2) a distance of eighty rods more or less and terminating at the morthwest corner of the continuest quarter of said section number two (2). All in the Toun of Nounds View, County of Rangey Minnesota.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 15th day of June A.D. 1908, at the residence of G.
