SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

September 25th, 1905.

Whereas, upon the petition of twelve (12) legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed---is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 32, Township 31, Range 22 west, thence running east on the south line of said Township 31 a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to the southwest corner of the south post quarter of the southeast quarter of said section Town and Range and there terminating

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 25th day of September A.D. 1905, at John Hughes residence causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against---the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 32, Township 31, Range 22 west, thence running east on the south line of said Town 31, a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said section, Town and Range and there terminating

It is hereby ordered determined and agreed that said town of Mounds View be allotted the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile and the town of Centerville the east $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile provided however that the said town of Centerville pay John Miller \$50.00 damages as agreed by both towns.

It is therefore Ordered and Determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
