

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

June 2, 1885.

Whereas, upon the petition of six legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the center of section fourteen (14) in township thirty (30) range twenty-three (23) in the town of Mounds View running north on quarter lines of northeast quarter and northwest quarter of section fourteen (14) as near to Turtle Lake as practicable thence northwest on the shore of the lake running as near to the same as practicable to section eleven (11) following the lake shore and between the house and barn of H. Bucher, Senior leaving some twenty foot (20) distance from outside of road bed continuing on said shore as the ground will admit to the north end of said lake and intersect the County road at that point.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 27th day of May A.D. 1885, at the house of Thomas Chaskey in the afternoon on section (11) causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met a such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point being the center of section fourteen (14) in Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) in the Town of Mounds View running north on quarter lines of northeast quarter and northwest quarter of section fourteen (14) as near to Turtle Lake as practicable, thence northwesterly on the shore of the Lake running as near to the same as practicable to section eleven (11) following the Lake Shore and between the house and barn of Henry Bucher, Senior leaving some twenty foot (20) distance from outside of road bed continuing on said shore as the ground will admit to the north end of said lake and intersect the County road at that point.

It is therefore Ordered and Determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway—roads wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
