PETITION FOR A CARTWAY

July 9, 1867

H. F. Brainard, Chairman, Board of Supervisors, New Canada:

The undersigned would most respectfully make petition for a cartway to be located upon (or as near as practicable) the following route, viz: Commencing at or near the Southeast corner of Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 4, and running due South to Section line, thence South by East to an intersection with the new or prairie road, said road being located and running from St. Paul to White Bear Lake.

Your petitioner would respectfully state that there is no road nor cartway leading to or from his property; said property being the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, and that said cartway is essential to his interests as a resident farmer.

Your action in this is humbly asked, and your petitioner will ever pray.
