

FINAL ROAD ORDER

April 6, 1870

Whereas, we, the undersigned Supervisors of said town, upon the petition of Isai Vincent, N. R. Fitzhugh, John Hoffman, Johan Sherffbillik, Ch. Fischer, Frederick Hoerchner, Philipp Kohn, Philipp Hoqsch, Ye Yo Sand, M. Vincent, Gail Langlais, Thomas Vincent, Arnold Yungmann, John Schenpp, Cundford Dunback, legal voters, copies of said petition having been posted as required by law, did personally on the 21st day of March, A.D. 1870, examine the route of a certain road asked for in same petition, namely, being on Section line between Sections 3 and 4 and 9 and 10 or as near thereto as may be practicable, and did previous to laying out said road, appoint a time and place for a meeting for the hearing of reasons for or against the same, which time and place were legally notified by written notices posted in three of the most public places in said town, eight days before said meeting, and said meeting was held, and upon consideration of the reasons for and against the laying out of said road, we are of opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper, and will promote the public interest, and whereas we determined to lay out said road according to said petition and caused a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor whose report of said survey is as follows:

Beginning at S.E. corner Section 9, thence West 1320 feet, thence North 2640 feet, thence North 7° 56' W. 926 feet, thence North 23° 55' W. 741 feet; thence North 60° 45' E. 126 feet; thence North 12° 35' W. 537½ ft. N. thence North 17° 20' E. 764 feet; thence North 43° 13' E. 585 feet; thence North 24° 18' E. 1585 feet; thence North 14° 58' E. 580 feet; thence North 37° 02' W. 301 feet; thence North 33° 17½' E. 719 feet; thence North to corner post of N.E. corner Section 4.

Now, therefore, we do order and determine that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established as by said survey and plat in this order recited appears, and said road is hereby declared a public highway four (4) rods wide, the line of said survey to be the center of said road.

PETITION FOR NEW ROAD

April 6, 1870.

To the Supervisors of the Town of New Canada,
County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota:

The undersigned legal voters, residing within one mile of the road to be laid out, hereby petition you to lay out a new road of the width of four rods, as follows: being on Section lines between Sections Nine (9) and Ten (10), and Four (4) and Three (3). Beginning at the South end of line between Sections Nine and Ten and running North to township line or as near there as may be practicable.

The names of the owners over which the road is to pass, which are known to your petitioners are the following:
