

To the Supervisors of the Town of New Canada  
 in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned legal voters owning real estate within one mile of the road to be laid out hereby petition you to lay out a new road of the width of four rods, as follows: the said road is to commence at a point at or near the Harvester Works in said town, running in a North-easterly direction through Sections 27, 22, 23, 14 and 13 to a point in the Northeast quarter of said Section 13, on the line between the Counties of Ramsey and Washington, thence Northerly to the line between the towns of New Canada and White Bear. The names of the owners of the land over which the road is to pass, which are known to your petitioners are the following:

and your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road and cause the same to be opened according to law.
