Whereas, upon petition of eight legal voters owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places in said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows: viz: Set forth as described in the petition. And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did, within thirty days, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 30th day of March A.D. 1878, at the house of John Brochman on Section 13 in said town, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicants had at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, a survey of said road having been made and a plat thereof put on file in the Clerk's office the description of which is as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the county line between Washington and Ramsey Counties, where the section line between Sections Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) intersects said county line between Sections Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13), Eleven (11) and Fourteen (14) until it intersects the road that runs to Mud Lake; thence running due West along said section line one mile, more or less, until it intersects the section line between Sections Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), thence due South along said last named section line one mile, more or less, until it intersects the section line between Sections Fourteen (14) and Twenty-three (23), thence due West along said last named section line until it intersects the White Bear Lake road.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established, according to the description aforesaid and the report and plat accompanying it, which is hereby made a part of this order. And we, the Supervisors of said town, taking into consideration the advantages and benefits the said road is and confers on the owners of lands on which the said road as described in the above petition We assess the damages to each and everyone of the said owners, the sum of ten cents.

The undersigned legal voters owning real estate within one mile of the road to be laid out hereby petition you to lay out a new road of the width of four rods as follows:

Commencing at a point on the county line between Washington and Ramsey Counties where the section line between Sections Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) intersect said county line between Sections Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13), Eleven (11) and Fourteen (14) until it intersects the road that runs to Mud Lake, Thence running due West along said Section line one mile more or less between Sections Thirteen and Fourteen (14), thence due South along said last named Section line, one mile more or less, until it intersects the Section line between Sections fourteen (14) and Twenty-three (23), thence due West along said last named Section line until it intersects the White Bear Lake Road. The names of the owners of the land over which the said road is to pass which are known to your petitioners are the following:

William K. Dixon, Bruggerman.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed at once to lay out said road and cause the same to be opened according to law.

DECLARING COUNTY ROAD

To the Board of County Commissioners
of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota:

The undersigned freeholders of the County of Ramsey do hereby petition your Honorable Board for the establishment and improving of a highway running into more than one town of said County and not within the limits of any incorporated city, and described as follows:

The East and West Road known as Larpenteur Avenue, being 66 feet in width, the center line of which is the Southerly line of Sections 14, and 13, situated in the township of New Canada in Ramsey County, Minnesota, extending from White Bear Avenue on the West to the Ramsey County line on the east a distance of two miles, excepting the southerly portion of said road thru section 14, being within the City limits of St. Paul, and to be connected with other roads as follows: said road connects with White Bear Avenue in such county outside the city of St. Paul, but leading into the said City of St. Paul,

And your petitioners pray that you constitute and declare said public highway a County Road,

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to improve said road and cause the same to be graded and surfaced with macadam or gravel according to law.

County Attorney O'Brien stated that the petition constituting Larpenteur Avenue, a County Road as presented at the meeting of February 2nd, was entirely legal.

It is suggested that when this road is to be improved that the part of said road within the city limits be included in the specifications and that the Commissioner of Public Works of the City of Saint Paul be directed to approve of said specifications and of the improvement of said road.

With this in mind Commissioner Churchill made a motion seconded Keller, that the County Surveyor be directed to draw up the necessary plans and specifications for grading and graveling the same and to take the matter up with the Commissioner of Public Works with a view of having the project OK'd to ascertain whether the city would share in the expenses of the construction of said road and same carried by the following vote:
