SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

County Road "G"

State of Minnesota, County of Ramsey, Town of New Canada,

Whereas, upon the petition of seven legal voters, residing and owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out copies of said petition having been first duly posted in three of the most public places in said town at least ten days before any action was had in relation thereto; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition in as follows, viz:

Commencing at a point on the St. Paul, Lake Phalen and White Bear Lake Road, where said road crosses the section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) Township 29, Range 22, thence running due west on section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) sections three (3) and ten (10) and sections four (4) and nine (9) until it intersects the public road on the East shore of Garvin Lake, between sections four (4) and nine (9) in said town.

And whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 1st day of September 1879 at the house of William Bohman on section 1 in said town, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town, at least ten days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard say and all persons for or against laying out the same, we appeared and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying the descriptions of which is as follows:

Commencing at a point on the St. Paul, Lake Phalen and White Bear Road, where said road crosses the section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) Township 29, Range 22, thence running due west on section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) sections three (3) and ten (10) and sections four (4) and nine (9) until it intersects the public road on the East shore of Garvin Lake between sections four (4) and nine (9) in said town.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and this report and plat accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway, four rods wide, this description above given being the center of said road.

ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES

County Road "C"

Whereas, a road was laid out on the 17th day of September, A.D. 1879, by the undersigned Supervisors of the said town of New Canada, on the petition of seven legal voters owning real estate within one mile of said road, which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows:

Commencing at a point on the St. Paul, Lake Phalen and W.B. Lake Road, where said road crosses the section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) Township 29, Range 22, thence running due west on section line between sections two (2) and eleven (11) sections three (3) and ten (10) and sections four (4) and nine (9) until it intersects the public road on the East shore of Garvais Lake, between sections four (4) and nine (9) in said town. And not being able to agree with the owners of the following lands claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which said highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right, taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants, and owners, as well as the disadvantages, we have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
