## LITTLE CANADA ROAD or #7-C

## FINAL ROAD ORDER

STATE OF NINHESOTA ) COUNTY OF RAMSET ) SS TOWN OF NEW CAMADA )

Whereas, upon the petition of eleven legal voters reciding or owning real estate within one mile of the read proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said new read is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vis:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Paul Hillette's land in Section Right, on the Saint Paul and Little Canada road; thence running in a northeasterly direction about two hundred feet at a point where it strikes the public high between Sections Right and Five in said town, and vacating said portion of the road from the point where it strikes the public highway between Sections Right and Five to the St. Paul and Little Canada road.

And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did, within thirty days make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would neet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 34th day of July A.B. 1876, at the Saint John House in Section Eight in said town, esseing copies of such notice to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town at least ten days previous to said meeting; and having met at such time and place as above memed in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicants had at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving personally to each said occupant we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the epinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Paul Millette's land in Section Eight on the Saint Paul and Little Canada road, thence running in a Northeasterly direction about two hundred feet at a point where it strikes the public road between Sections Eight and Five in said town.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rode wide, the description above given being that the above described road is to pass on Thomas L. Graci's land, adjoining Paul Hillette's land.
