## Vacate a Road

Whereas, upon the petition of ten legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile; of the road proposed in said petition to be vacated, copies of said petition having been first duly pested up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relating therete, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, visi

Commencing at a point on Edgerton Street at er near the quarter section of section 17 and running due east four-hundred and sixty-six (466) feet said Scotland road being thirty-three feet wide and the petitioners pray that you will proceed to vacate said road.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 4th day of Sept. A.D. 1874, at the Town Hall at 10 o'clock causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway night pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we preceded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against—the same, and being of the epinion that such road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be premeted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on Edgerton Street at or near the quarter section of section 17 and running due east four-hundred and sixty-six (466) feet said Scotland road being thirty three feet wide and the petitioners pray that you will proceed to vacate said road.

It Is Therefore Ordered and Determined that a road be, and the same is hereby vacated and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be altered, highway 33 feet wide, the said description above given being the center of said read.
