The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road in said Town would report that the following is a correct survey thereof, as made by me, under your directions, to-wit:

A road 66 feet in width the southerly line of said road being described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 8, Township 29, Range 22, thence S. $86^{\circ} 55'$ W. 530.45 feet to a granite monument, thence S. $56^{\circ} 45'$ W. 255 feet to a point which is S. 20° E. 178.86 feet from a point on the section line between sections 5 and 8, Township 29, Range 22, 507.54 feet east of the Section corner of Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 said town and Range: Also beginning at the above mentioned Northeast corner of Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of section 8, Township 29, Range 22 and running east on the north line of said section 8, 326.00 feet to a point; and the northerly line of said road to be 66 feet northerly and at right angles to the above described South line.

And that below is a correct plat of said road according to said survey.
