

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Vacate a Road

May 10, 1906.

Whereas, Upon the petition of eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles— of said road proposed in said petition to be vacated; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting copies thereof, and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed vacation is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the north end of block 13, village of Gladstone at a point 124 feet east from the northwest corner of the said block, then south six-hundred feet to Ripley Avenue then east twenty feet on Ripley Avenue the north (600) six-hundred feet, then west twenty feet to the joint of beginning.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 10th day of May, A.D. 1906. at 9 o'clock in the forenoon at Town Hall, Gladstone causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the said vacation the same, and being of opinion that such vacating was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to vacate said alley, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as set forth is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the north end of block 13, Village of Gladstone at a point 124 feet east from the northwest corner of the said block then south six-hundred feet to Ripley Avenue, then east twenty feet on Ripley Avenue, then north (600) six-hundred feet then west twenty feet to the point of beginning.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby vacated and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public-highway vacated rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
