SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

RAMSEY COUNTY)
SS
TOWN OF NEW CANADA)

Whereas, upon petition signed in writing of seven (7) legal voters residing within one mile of the route hereinafter described for a public highway a copy of their petition having been first duly posted as required by law, we the Supervisors of said town did on the 15th day of March, 1872, personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the road leading from St. Paul to Lake Phalen at or near the South East corner of Northeast quarter of Section 29, thence running North along the Section line between Sections 29, 28, 20, 21, 17, & 16 in said town to intersect a road leading North from the North line of said Section 17 & 16, and having before determined to lay out said road fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten (10) days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons and having heard such as were offered for or against the laying out said road, and being of opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petition and determined to lay out said road, we did on the 16th day of March, 1872, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor who made report to us,

It is therefore endorsed and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to said survey and the plat therunto annexed and made part of this order which is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.

In witness whereof, we the said supervisors, have herunto set our hands this 10th day of April, 1872.

PETITION OF COUNTY ROAD

New Canada

Arcade St. or County Road #113

Meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of New Canada the 10th day of April, 1872. The Board ordered the following to be extended, to-wit:

To the Board of Supervisors of New Canada Town, Ramsey County, Minn.:
The undersigned freeholders of said town residing within one mile of the road herein asked for, petition for a road in said town of New Canada, to be laid out and opened as follows:

Commencing at a point on the road leading from St. Paul to Lake Phalen, at or near the S.E. corner of N.E. quarter (¼) of Section 29, thence running due North along the Section line between Sections 29 & 28, 20 & 21, 17 & 16 in said town to intersect at a road leading North from the North line of said Sections 17 & 16. That the following are the names of the owners of the lands through which said road will pass, so far as they are known as can be ascertained, to-wit:

C. H. Shumair, Vincino D. Walsh, V. F. Drake, P. S. Taylor, James Iglehart, George Wells, Robert P. Lewis, Ellen Mackalin, Robert Bryant, Wm. Callagher, Estate of Josiah B. Heylin, Jas. Brings, Mathias Klaus, Peter Schmetura, Richard Marian, P. Paine, Jas. H. Simpson, G. G. Murray, John Wagner, Fred Jostyke, That the location of said road will benefit a large number of persons in the neighborhood thereof.

Gentlemen:

This is to inform you that effective Sept. 7, County Road "B" between the West County Line and Arcade St., and Arcade St., between County Road "B" and the new S. T. H. #36, become county roads. A portion of this road is now being used as a temporary detour by the State Highway Department, but this portion will be maintained by Ramsey County and we will be compensated for this maintenance during the duration of the detour.

County Road "B" will be carried as Road #15; and Arcade St., will be carried as Road #43, for the time being.
