From Hennepin Co. Line to 827.64 ft. East of Cleveland

Whereas, upon application in writing of A. Chemedlin, Joseph Holdenreid and others, six (6) legal voters living within one (1) mile of the road hereinafter described for a public highway, a copy of their petition having been duly posted up as required by law, we the Supervisors of said town did on the 28th day of March personally examine the road proposed in said petition for a public highway, to-wit:

Commencing at the corner of Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, Township 29, Range 23, var. 10° 40 East, running East on section line between Sections 5, 8, 61.20 chains, thence South 54° 1/4 East 6.48 chains, thence North 87° 3/4 East 7.00 chains, thence North 51° 1/4 East 6.00 chains to section line, thence East on section line 12.54 chains to a road bearing North and Southwards and having before determined to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town eight (8) days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons and having heard such as were offered for or against laying out the said road and being of the opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road we did on the 28th day of March, 1861 cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor who made report to us as follows:
