

COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S ROAD ORDER

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, held July 6th, 1880, the report of the committee appointed by us at our last session to examine the road hereinafter named, have reported that they met at the time and place designated in our order of appointment, and examined the highway proposed to be vacated viz:

Beginning at the quarter section corner on west boundary of section six (6) Township twenty-nine (29) Range twenty-two (22) thence running and following said old highway known as the Columbus road to the Township line between the towns of New Canada and Woods View in said Racine County, and recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for said highway be granted; it is therefore ordered and determined that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that a highway be and is hereby vacated according to the description above given, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which such road is vacated that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be vacated without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by the following persons by reason of the laying out, & C., of such highway across their lands as follows:
