

AN ACT

County Road "B" or County Rd. #15.

November 12, 1881.

To provide for surveying locating opening and establishing a County road in the town of Rose and New Canada in Ramsey County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section One

That John Robinson, John Hardy and Edward Boyd of Ramsey County are hereby appointed Commissioners to survey, locate and establish a County road beginning at the west boundary of Ramsey County at the section part of sections eight (8) and seventeen (17) in the town of Rose in said County, running east on section line between sections eight (8) and seventeen (17) nine (9) and sixteen (16) ten (10) and fifteen (15) eleven (11) and fourteen (14) twelve (12) and thirteen (13) in the town of Rose; thence east between sections seven (7) and eighteen (18) eight (8) and seventeen (17) to the southeast quarter of section eight (8).

Section Two

Said Commissioners or a majority of them shall meet at the County Auditor's Office in the City of St. Paul on or before the first (1st) day of June, A. D. one-thousand eight-hundred and eighty-two (1882) and then make oath that they will faithfully discharge their duties as provided by this act and impartially assess damages if any they find to be sustained by the owners of land through which said road may run which oath shall be filed in said Auditor's Office; and proceed to discharge their duties in locating surveying and establishing said road, and assessing damages if any which may be sustained by any person by reason thereof.

Section Three

The said Commissioners are hereby authorized to employ in discharging their duties under this act one (1) chairman, one (1) assessor, and one (1) surveyor; Provided that said Commissioners, assessor, and Chairman shall not receive more than two (2) dollars per day, each, nor the surveyor more than five (5) dollars per day for such services.

Section Four

Any damages sustained and benefits received by the owners of real estate along the line of said road by reason of laying out and opening of said road shall be assessed and determined by said Commissioners and shall be paid and collected in the manner now provided by general laws for the assessment and collection of damages and benefits for the laying out and opening roads and said damages shall be fixed by the townships through which said road runs and any person feeling aggrieved by any award or assessment of damages aforesaid shall have the right of appeal in the same manner and with like effect as if said damages had been assessed under the general Law of this State provided that notice of the time and place of the meeting of said Commissioners to assess said damages shall be given to the owners or persons in possession of said real estate six days before said meeting of said Commission and which notice may be served by publication for six days in a daily newspaper published at the city of St. Paul or personally upon said owners or persons in possession.

An Act, Cont'd.

Section Five

Said Commissioners shall cause an accurate plat and map of the survey and location of said road to be made which together with a statement of their appraisal of damages shall be filed in the office of the County Auditor in Ramsey County and thereupon the establishment of said road shall be deemed complete and the supervisors of the several towns through which said road shall pass, shall cause to be opened and worked so much of said road as then lies in their respective towns upon being notified by the County Auditor aforesaid of said County that such plat has been filed as above prescribed, and the County Auditor of said County is hereby required to publish the statement or award of damages assessed with the name of the owners if known and description of the land or tracts through which said road was located, and the amount if any awarded for damages to said respective tracts for three successive weeks of some newspaper printed and published in the city of St. Paul in Ramsey County and thereupon due notice of the said assessment of damages shall be deemed as given to all persons interested in the said tracts of land and thereupon within thirty (30) days thereafter the right of appeal to either a Justice or District Court as the case may be shall lie as herein before provided.

Section Six

The expenses of surveying locating and establishing said road shall be paid by the County of Ramsey aforesaid.

Section Seven

This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## COMMISSIONERS REPORT

November 12, 1881.

Co. Rd. "B" or Co. Rd. #15.

We the undersigned Commissioners appointed by the act of the Legislature approved November 12th, A.D. 1881 a copy of which is hereto attached beg leave to submit the following report.

(1) We as authorized in said act have had the road contemplated therein surveyed and we herewith present an accurate plat and map of the survey and location of said road.

(2) On Saturday the 11th day of March A.D. 1882, at the hour of two o'clock P.M. of that day, we met at the house of F. C. Sherron on the line of said road in the Town of Rose, Ramsey County, Minnesota, having given due notice by publication a copy of which notice attached to the affidavit of E.H. Hall of the publication thereof is hereto annexed. That we would meet at that time and place to assess any damages sustained and benefits received by the Owners of the Real Estate along the line of said road, by reason of the laying out and opening of the same, and that we then and there proceeded to assess the damages sustained and benefits received in the premises that we then and there heard the evidence of Israel Crossley and Truman Smith as to the damages resulting to the lands of the former by the laying out and opening of said road, after which we adjourned to meet at the office of J.J. Evans in the city of St. Paul in said Ramsey County on Saturday the 18th day of March A. D. 1882, at ten o'clock A. M.

That we then and there duly met pursuant to adjournment and completed the assessment of the damages and benefits on the lands through which said road is laid out as follows:
