

SUPERVISORS' ORDER TO DISCONTINUE PORTION OF ROAD No. 19.

April 9, 1878

Whereas, upon the petition of six legal voters residing within one mile of the road mentioned in said petition to be vacated, copies of said petition having been posted up in three public places of said Town, twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, said discontinuance is described in said petition as follows:

Commencing at a point on Lake Como Road $\frac{1}{2}$ mile West of S.E. Corner of Section 17, thence North one mile to a point $\frac{1}{2}$ mile West of N.E. Corner of Section 17 or commencing on the line of the Section 17 on Como and Minneapolis road thence North one mile.

Upon receiving said petition we did within thirty days make out three notices and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon said application to-wit: the 9th day of April, 1878, at the house of Patrick Hogan in Section 17 in said Town and causing said notices to be properly posted 14 days previous to such meeting and having met according to notice and being satisfied that the applicant had caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be served according to law, as shown by affidavit, we examined personally said highway and heard all reasons for or against said discontinuance and being of the opinion that such discontinuance was just and that the public interests would be promoted thereby, we determined to grant the prayer of said petitioners and determined to discontinue and vacate said road.

It is therefore ordered and determined that said road be and the same is hereby discontinued and vacated according to the description aforesaid.
