SUPERVISOR'S ROAD ORDER

March 5, 1928

WHEREAS, Upon the petition of legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: lay out and establish a road: The East 33 ft. of the W. 736.50 ft. of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26, Twp. 30, R. 22.

AND WHEREAS, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing, and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 5th day of March, 1928, at two o'clock in the afternoon at the intersection of Cedar Ave. and Highway No. 1. causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and being of opinion that such road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to establish and lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so ----- is as follows, to-wit: same as above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DETERMINED, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road two (2) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
